4. Receive Staff Updates

Action: Eric Harrold stated that the auditors will be coming July 23, 2018 and reviewed:

- Staff changes: Due to a recent death, one position is being reviewed for possible changes.
- MAA: More changes to requirements, working with LGA.
- Sustainability: Receiving positive response from the contractors, training is ongoing.
- Budget: A plan from the BOS was presented to fill the funding loss for Birth & Beyond in the amount of \$325,000 with another \$325,000 possible in September 2018.
- Revenue: Even with an 18% drop the first year, expectations have been met so far. The projected backfill should cover this funding drop.
